### Jurisdiction - General Information

Cameroon has been a Contracting Party to the Paris Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property since May 10, 1964. It has also been a Contracting Party to the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT) since January 24, 1978, but it can be designated only through the African Intellectual Property Organization (OAPI).

Cameroon is a member of the Organisation Africaine de la Propriété Intellectuelle ([OAPI](#)).
