Particularities of patent protection in Guyana

The patent protection term is 16 years from grant. A **Patent Term Extension** of 5, 10 or more years can be granted in exceptional circumstances.

If you apply for a national patent on the basis of a patent granted in the United Kingdom (GB) or an European Patent validated in the United Kingdom, within 3 years from the date of issue, registration will normally be granted and the patent obtained will expire together with the GB patent.
