Burkina Faso has been a Contracting Party to the Paris Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property since November 19, 1963. It has also been a Contracting Party to the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT) since March 21, 1989, but it can be designated only through the African Intellectual Property Organization (OAPI). In addition, it is a party to the Patent Law Treaty (PLT).

Burkina Faso is a member of the Organisation Africaine de la Propriété Intellectuelle (OAPI).
