Jurisdiction - General Information

Bulgaria has been a Contracting Party to the Paris Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property since June 13, 1921. It has also been a Contracting Party to the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT) since May 21, 1984. In addition, it is a party to the Budapest Treaty on the International Recognition of the Deposit of Microorganisms for the Purposes of Patent Procedure.

Bulgaria is also a member of the European Patent Organization (EPO) and belongs to the "European patents with unitary effect" system, started on June 1, 2023, which provides a unitary effect for an European patent (EP) granted in 17 of the 27 European Union member countries (updated January 2024).

Online Patent Register and Online Gazette

Bulgaria has an <u>Online Register</u> for patents, another for validated EP patents accessible at this <u>link</u>, one for **utility models** available at this <u>link</u>, and one on **Supplementary Protection Certificates (SPCs)** accessible at the following <u>link</u>. Bulgaria also has an <u>Online Gazette</u>.

Features and search functionalities

The Online Register has a **Bulgarian** and an **English interface**.

Through the Online Register you can search patents, utility models and SPC registers and retrieve information about the **Fee Payment** and **Legal Status**.

The Online Register can also be searched by Applicant/Inventor Name and by Priority Data.

The Online Gazette is published twice per month in Bulgarian as Electronic Journal (BPO) since October 2017, with an index in English. This edition as well as the previous Official Bulletin (OB) is searchable and downloadable in PDF format from the BPO <u>link</u> or from the OB <u>link</u> starting from 2009.

European patents designating Bulgaria (when there is a publication in the Official Gazette for the filed Bulgarian translation) can be searched in the National Register of the European patents or in the European Patent Register.

Search tips

A search can be made among patents, utility models, SPCs and European Patents by selecting the respective register icon.

Legal Status information is displayed (in Bulgarian or in English), e.g. Terminated for non-payment of annual fees for patent no."66419" as well as the indication of the latest annual fee paid.

The **Full Publication** is available apparently for the recent publications only, and can be downloaded by choosing and clicking on the "Document type" preferred (kind of publication are reported in Bulgarian but can be identified by the Kind Code A1, B1, etc).
