Jurisdiction - General Information

The Czech Republic has been a Contracting Party to the Paris Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property and to the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT) since January 1, 1993. In addition, it is a party to the Budapest Treaty on the International Recognition of the Deposit of Microorganisms for the Purposes of Patent Procedure and the Patent Law Treaty (PLT).

The Czech Republic is also a member of the European Patent Organization (EPO).

Online Patent Register and Online Gazette

The Czech Republic has an **Online Register** and an **Online Gazette**.

Features and search functionalities

The Online Register has a **Czech** and **English interface**. It covers Czech national patents (P) since n.1, utility models (UM), European Patents validated in the Czech Republic, and **Supplementary Protection Certificates (SPCs)**.

Through the Online Register you can retrieve information on Legal Status, Fee Payment, Supplementary Protection Certificates (SPCs), and access the Full Publications.

The Online Register can also be searched by **PCT Application/Publication Number**, by **Applicant/Inventor Name**, and by **Priority Data**.

The Online Gazette is published weekly in Czech. It can be searched using several criteria and downloadable in PDF format. The coverage is from 2000 to present.

European Patents validated in the Czech Republic can be searched in the patent register by application or publication number or in the European Patent Register.

Search tips

To search the Online Register by **PCT Application/Publication Number**, use the following format: e.g., Number of published PCT application (WO): WO2004043449.

An example of a Legal Status is "Valid document" for patent 305611 (as on 27.10.2023).

A file history is reported in the record, while main events only are published in the gazette and available as pdf copy.

Full Publications can be downloaded by clicking on "Full document".

A "Global search" is also possible from this <u>link</u> to retrieve all national and regional IP rights with effects in the Czech Republic including patents, designs and trademarks.

The Czech alphabet comprises several diacritical characters and, in view of that, to make the search easier, the online register offers a choice between a search considering or regardless diacritics.
