Particularities of patent protection in Grenada

A patent can be registered in Grenada according to a national procedure pursuant to the Patents Act (No. 16 of 2011) or as a re-registration of a patent granted in the United Kingdom (GB), including a European patent validated in GB, if filed within three years from the date of registration in the United Kingdom (Cap. 283).

Utility model certificates shall expire after 7 years from the filing date.
