Honduras has been a Contracting Party to the Paris Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property since February 4, 1994. It has also been a Contracting Party to the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT) since June 20, 2006. In addition, it is a party to the Budapest Treaty on the International Recognition of the Deposit of Microorganisms for the Purposes of Patent Procedure.

Honduras is also part of the regional IP information platform LATIPAT.

Honduras does not have an Online Register. It has an Online Gazette (Publicaciones Patentes).

Features and search functionalities

The Online Gazette is usually published every week or two weeks in Spanish in the form of two lists: patent application cover pages (Avisos de Publicación) and notices of grant (Resoluciones). The publications from the current calendar year are generally available online.

Particularities of patent protection in Honduras

An instrument of **Patent Term Extension** is available. The normal patent term of 20 years can be extended in case of a delay in the registration process (if the grant takes more than 5 years from the filing date or 3 years from the examination request) or in obtaining the regulatory approval of a pharmaceutical product (more than 3 years from the application).
