Particularities of patent protection in Saint Lucia

A patent can be registered in Saint Lucia either pursuant to the Patents Act 2001 which provides for local patent applications, or pursuant to the Commercial Code and Laws of Saint Lucia 1975 which provides for applications to extend rights under the registration obtained in the United Kingdom (GB).

If one applies for a patent based on an existing patent issued in the United Kingdom, within 3 years of the date of issue, registration will normally be granted and the patent obtained will expire together with the GB patent.
