Nicaragua has been a Contracting Party to the Paris Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property since July 3, 1996. It has also been a Contracting Party to the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT) since March 6, 2003. In addition, it is a party to the Budapest Treaty on the International Recognition of the Deposit of Microorganisms for the Purposes of Patent Procedure.

Nicaragua is also part of the regional IP information platform <u>LATIPAT</u> and a member of the "SISTEMA DE COOPERACIÓN SOBRE ASPECTOS DE INFORMACIÓN OPERACIONAL Y DE PROPIEDAD INDUSTRIAL" (PROSUR).
