It has also been a Contracting Party to the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT) since January 24, 1978, but it can be designated only through the African Intellectual Property Organization (OAPI). In addition, it is a party to the Patent Law Treaty (PLT).

Togo is a member of the Organisation Africaine de la Propriété Intellectuelle (OAPI).
