In addition, it is a party to the Budapest Treaty on the International Recognition of the Deposit of Microorganisms for the Purposes of Patent Procedure.

The Online Register has an **English interface**.

Through the Online Register you can retrieve information on PCT National Phase Entry and Legal Status.

The Online Register can also be searched by PCT Application Number and by Applicant/Inventor Name.

An access to a limited **Dossier/File Wrapper Information** (Correspondence) is also available.

The Online Gazette is published monthly in English. It can be searched by date and downloaded in PDF format. Part 2 includes patent-related notifications. Its coverage is from 2010 to present.

Fee Payment information is occasionally reported in the bibliographic record as "Renewal(s)".
